

## 2.36 TRAFFIC AND PARKING SAFETY STATEMENT

---

In the interests of safety for our children and other road users, parents and staff are expected to follow these procedures for parking and road use.

- Please use the turning circle for collection of children and move to the front of the line.
- DO NOT park for more than a short period of time in the turning circle or across its entrance and exit. This includes in rainy weather. This affects the safety of others.
- Be aware and considerate of our neighbour's driveways, particularly when turning into the turning bay. Do not park across or in any driveway, and when parking adjacent to a driveway you must ensure you leave adequate room for access.
- No parking on the grass or footpath in front of the church.
- From time to time, permission may be sought from families where the mother is pregnant or a family member is disabled, to drive and park on the open grassed area to facilitate easy access to drop off and pick up their child.
- Please park courteously (i.e. leave enough space for others to park, and do not park others in etc.) At peak times, if your child(ren) are mobile, please park further up the road and leave the spaces closer to the school for parents/carers with babies.
- **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANY CHILD UNATTENDED IN A CAR AT ANY TIME.** If required, ask another parent to watch your baby while you pick up/drop-off.
- Please ensure you hold your child's hand on entry and exit of the school. Other community members use the grassed space for participating in community classes and we cannot predict the comings and goings of these groups. It is best to always be aware of moving vehicles in the vicinity.
- Children may only exit through the gate in the company of their carer. Please ensure other children do not exit with you.
- Observe all speed limits at all times on Moore Avenue and within the Church grounds,
- It is the parents' responsibility to ensure that any carers who collect their children are also aware of these guidelines.
